# **DESCRIPTION**

Seasonal Gallery Staff are critical to this mission during peak visitation periods—summer, spring, and winter breaks—by ensuring playful learning and meaningful family interactions for all guests.

Seasonal Gallery Staff support museum-wide programs such as Story Time, Sensory Play, the Art and Innovation Lab, and special events. They are knowledgeable about CMOM exhibits, activities, and the calendar of upcoming events. Seasonal team members engage with guests of all ages by providing museum directions, assisting with activities, modeling play, and fostering an inviting atmosphere. They are also responsible for maintaining cleanliness and resetting exhibits throughout their shifts.

This position is ideal for individuals seeking a temporary role in a dynamic, family-focused environment.

- 2. Report spills or cleaning needs to housekeeping immediately.
- 3. Help maintain an organized and clean museum environment during busy seasonal periods.
